- Step 1.** Get familiar with the detailed rules of recruitment, the required documents list and the recruitment schedule, which are available on our *website (click)*
- Step 2.** Specify the topic of your doctoral dissertation and select a Doctoral Supervisor (researcher at the University of Lodz). Prepare a concept of your dissertation under his/her supervision – it is one of the required documents in the recruitment process. If you have obtained the Doctoral Supervisor's consent to study under their care, *submit a statement*. If you have not received such consent, *submit an application for appointment* of the selected person as a Doctoral Supervisor of your doctoral dissertation.
- Step 3.** Register in the electronic recruitment system. Registration of candidates for Doctoral Schools 2021/2022 is available at: www.rekrutacja.uni.lodz.pl. Electronic registration is possible from 23.08.2021 to 27.08.2021.

Step 4. Get the required documents together and deliver them. The required documents list can be found on the *website of the Doctoral School*. Ready-made document templates are also available there. Remember to submit them within the time specified in the recruitment schedule!

Step 5. Register for English test. The date of the test is 13.09.2021.
