

Regulation No. 43 of the Rector of the University of Lodz dated 16 January 2023

on the recruitment schedule and admission limits to the Bio-Med-Chem Doctoral School of the University of Lodz and Lodz Institutes of the Polish Academy of Sciences for the academic year 2023/2024

Pursuant to Article 23(1) of the Act of 20 July 2018 Law on higher education and science [*Prawo o szkolnictwie wyższym i nauce*] (consolidated text Journal of Laws of 2022, item 574, as amended) as well as Section 3(1) and Section 3(4) of the Recruitment Rules for the University of Lodz Doctoral School of Social Sciences for the academic year 2023/2024, adopted by Resolution No. 410 of the UL Senate of 19 December 2022, I order as follows:

Section 1

I set out the recruitment schedule for the academic year 2023/2024 for the Bio-Med-Chem Doctoral School of the University of Lodz and Lodz Institutes of the Polish Academy of Sciences for candidates whose doctoral scholarship will be financed in whole or in part from external funds

Section 2

1. Admission limit to the Bio-Med-Chem Doctoral School of the University of Lodz and Lodz Institutes of the Polish Academy of Sciences for the academic year 2023/2024 is 30 persons. Places have been allocated to disciplines. Limits for individual disciplines:

The admission limit to the Bio-Med-Chem Doctoral School of the University of Lodz and Lodz Institutes of the Polish Academy of Sciences (without breakdown by discipline) for the academic year 2023/2024 for candidates whose doctoral scholarship will be financed in whole or in part from external funds is 20 persons.
